<u>Please note</u>: Projects entered, or entrant's portion of project, must have been completed no earlier than **January 1, 2018**, and no later than **December 31, 2018**. The date on the occupancy permit determines a project's completion.

- 1. Please complete an "Intent to Submit" form for each project entered in the 2019 EIC Awards.
- 2. Send your completed "Intent to Submit" form(s) (PDF document*) to emily@abckeystone.org by April 19, 2019.
- 3. EIC entry materials should be submitted via Dropbox, which will be provided to you after your "Intent to Submit" form is received. There is no cost to members to use the <u>Dropbox file sharing service</u>. Further explanation will be available about how to prepare the entry materials.
- 4. Project entry final deadline is **June 7, 2019, at 4:00 pm**. Payment is also due at this time. An invoice will be generated for your company based on the intent to submit forms.

• A-1: Commercial

Offices, retail stores, banks, hotels, fit-out of commercial tenant spaces*

- a. Under \$2 million
- b. \$2 to \$10 million
- c. \$10 to \$25 million
- d. \$25 to \$50 million
- e. Over \$50 million

• A-2: Industrial

Warehouses, manufacturing facilities, etc.

- a. Under \$2 million
- b. \$2 to \$10 million
- c. \$10 to \$25 million
- d. Over \$25 million

• A-3: Institutional

Schools, churches, theaters, facilities with "monumental" finishes.

- a. Under \$2 million
- b. \$2 to \$10 million

- d. \$25 to \$50 million
- e. Over \$50 million

• A-4: Healthcare

Hospitals, facilities where patient care requires high levels of sanitary finishes and complex support services. Heavy medical use.

PLEASE NOTE:

Each project may be entered in only ONE general contractor category.

The same project may be entered in various specialty contractor categories as appropriate, in addition to entry in a general contractor category.

• A-5: Renovation

No more than 20% increase in facility square footage, and area of renovation exceeds area of addition; includes historical renovation.

- a. Under \$1 million
- b. \$1-\$5 million
- c. Over \$5 million

• A-6: Residential**

- a. New Single Family
- b. New Multi-Unit
- c. Renovation Single Family
- d. Renovation Multi-Unit

• A-7: Pre-Engineered Buildings

Over 75% of facility area is pre-engineered.

• A-8: Medical Renovation

Renovation of a medical facility, as described in A-4. No more than 20% increase in facility square footage, and area of renovation exceeds area of addition.

- a. Under \$1 million
- b. \$1-\$5 million
- c. Over \$5 million

• A-9: Public Works/Infrastructure

Streets, parks, bridges, water or sewer treatment plants, where non-building work far exceeds building portion of the facility.

• A-10: Community/Public Service

General Contractor projects, regardless of type, which enhanced the community and used partially or fully donated resources. Entries should include information detailing the donated resources.

• N-1: Miscellaneous/Special Projects – Both GCs and SCs may enter this category

Projects that do not qualify for any of the above; includes equipment specialties.

*Doctor's offices, without extensive treatment facilities, should be entered in **Commercial**.

Elder care and retirement facilities should be entered in **Residential Multi-Unit category. However; if the largest portion is common area (recreation, dining, etc.), project should be entered in the **Commercial** category.
