### WOMEN IN THE TRADES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Applications are due no later than Friday, May 30, 2025

The Her Traditions Scholarship Program is sponsored by **Traditions Bank** and the **Keystone Chapter of Associated Builders & Contractors (ABC)** and is administered by the **Merit Shop Training & Research Center**.

Two (2) scholarships, each for \$1,000, will be made available to eligible applicants.

Eligible Applicants are limited to:

- 1. Women seeking to further their education in careers in construction; and,
- 2. Women who are enrolling in a trade school, college or university program that is directly related to a construction career; and
- 3. Women who permanently reside in Adams, Lancaster or York County, Pennsylvania

Award recipients will be selected by a Scholarship Selection Committee consisting of Traditions Bank and ABC Keystone Chapter solely based on merit and without regard for the race, color, religion, national origin, or gender of applicants.

- 1. Application shall be made on the form obtained from Traditions Bank offices and at the offices of the Keystone Chapter of Associated Builders & Contractors, Inc. - 2. All items or information requested in the application, must be submitted to the Center.

- 2. Selection will be made no later than June 15, 2025.
- 3. The scholarship funds will be forwarded directly to the recipient's educational institution upon receipt of a copy of the student's invoice showing a balance due from the educational institution for the 2025-2026 school term, and other information as designated by the Center.
